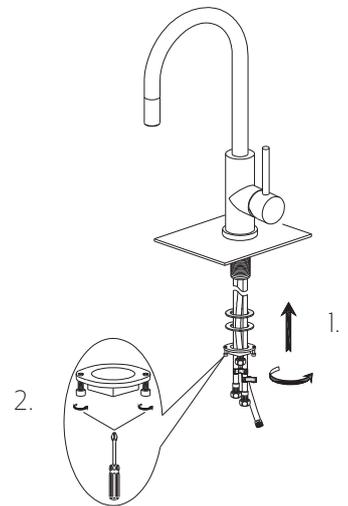
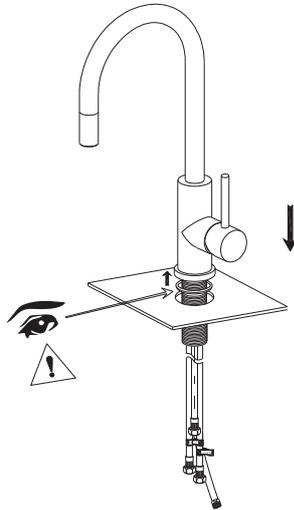
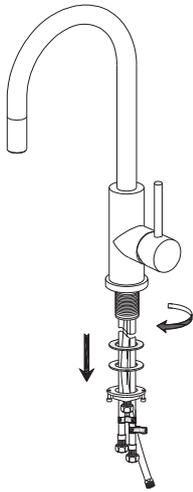
Note: This product must be installed by a licensed plumber. 1 Remove locking collar and washers

2 Feed all four flexy hoses through counter top cutout
***Note:** Ensure rubber is correctly recessed into base plate

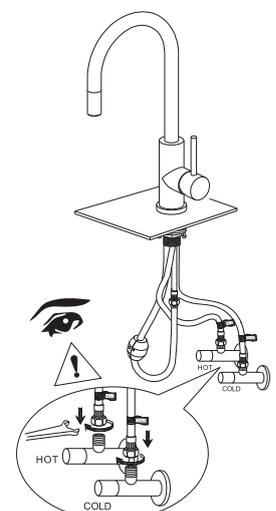
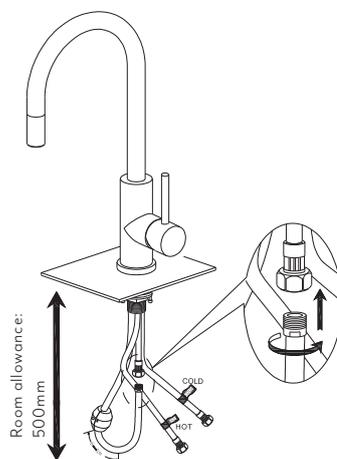

3 1. Replace both washers ensuring that the rubber washer goes on first.
 2. Use a screw driver to tighten the two bolts until the mixer is secured in place.



4 Connect weight to the pull-out hose. Test pull-out function and weight positioning before tightening with screw driver.

5 Connect pull-out hose to shorter flexy hose.

6 Connect Red and Blue Flexy hoses to Hot and Cold water outlets accordingly.



Regularly clean with mild liquid detergent or soap and water.



DO NOT use cream cleaners or bleach. These substances are abrasive.



DO NOT use cleaning pads with abrasive surfaces as this may scratch the material.
