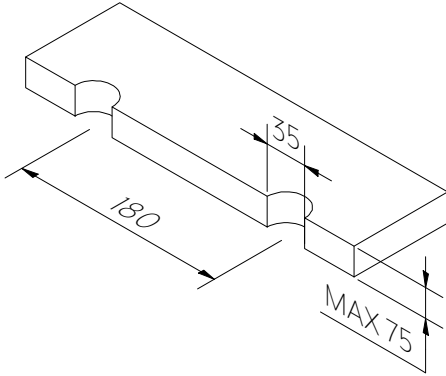

INSTALLATION GUIDE

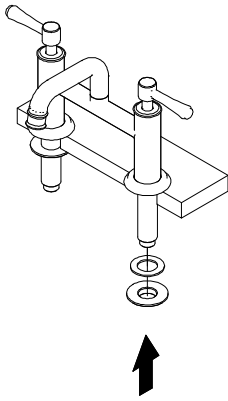
Note: This product must be installed by a licensed plumber. 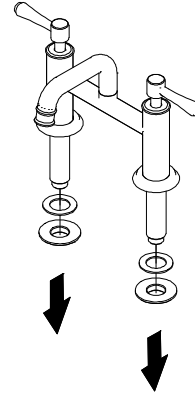
- ① Mark holes 180mm apart in bench top at desired position and drill 2x 35mm holes.



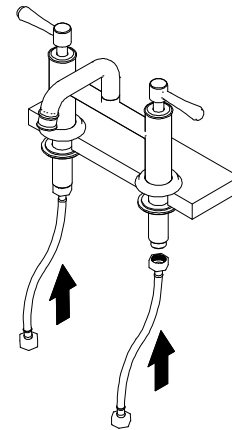
- ③ Fix washer and tighten fixing bracket to secure bridge mixer.



- ② Remove fixing brackets and washers and insert bridge mixer into drilled holes.

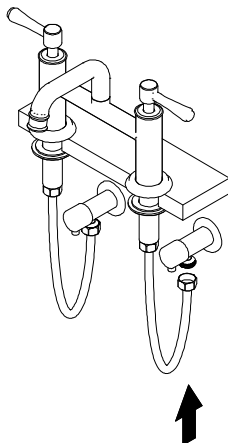


- ④ Ensuring rubbers are in place before screwing flexi hoses into the the bridge mixer.



- ⑤ Connect flexi hoses to water supply. Test and commission.

Note: Tighten aerator so that it cannot be removed by hand. WELs star rating applies only when this product is installed over a basin.



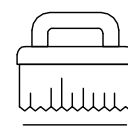
