


## EDEN SQUARE KITCHEN MIXER


## INSTALLATION GUIDE


Mark hole in benchtop at desired positon and drill a 35mm hole.






As shown in the figure, connect the H & C flexible hoses.



Install the basin mixer by fixing the washers, nut & screws on the underside of the benchtop.







Attach the two flexible hoses to water supply and hand tighten. Remove the
