


INSTALLATION - 2-OUTLET DIVERTER - IN-WALL COMPONENT


Determine the position for your diverter and mixer handles. Adjust the depth to ensure optimal set-out considering the wall finish material.

Ensure the body is level in all directions.

Fix to the wall structure using the appropriate screws.



2 Connect the water pipes. Flush pipes to ensure no debris is in the lines. Use appropriate thread sealant.
Check and ensure no leaks before proceeding.




Apply the wall and wall finish. Trim sleeve with a knife so that the edge is flush with the wall finish.*
Silicone between waterproof sleeve and wall.

*Mark and remove sleeves for easier cutting if neccessary.







Recommended set-back range 55-90mm from the wall finish surface.



INSTALLATION - HANDLE KIT




Push on the sleeve and backplate. Screw the dome on.





- 1. Push the handle onto the cartridge.
- 2. Fasten the grub screw underneath.
- 3. Screw on the handle stick.






ADJUSTING THE LIMITING COLLAR

The limiting collar must be set so that the maximum temperature coming out of your shower head is no more than **43 degrees Celcius**. Please use a temperature gauge.


- 1. Unscrew the dome and remove the limiting sleeve with needle nose pliers.
- 2. Put the handle on and run the water, use the temperature gauge to check the water temperature at the shower head. Once it's at 43 degrees Celcius, leave it in position and remove the handle again.
- 2. Re-install the sleeve and position the limiting sleeve so that rotation is limited to the current position of the cartridge (43 degrees Celsius).




SET 38 DEGREES CELSIUS

Depending on your inlet water temperatures, you may need to rotate the sleeve so the display temperature of 38 degrees Celsius is aligned to the handle mark.

Do this while the handle is rotated to the correct angle that the outlet water from the shower head is 38 degrees celcius.



Screw on diverter sleeve.
Slide diverter backplate onto the sleeve ensuring not to scratch.




Install handle by tightening grub screw with provided Allen key. Screw on handle stem, using o-ring to tighten.





