



In The Box

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Hold the towel rail against the wall, making the product and level the same as figure shown.
2. Mark this position on the wall like shown.
3. Place the fixing bracket on the circle that was marked in step 2. Use the pencil to draw a small circle as shown below. The power cord is to be fixed on the right side.
4. Drill the hole (Diameter: 8mm, Depth 45mm) on the centre of the small circle. Then use a hammer to knock the plastic expander into wall completely. Insert the screw into the plastic expander fixed on the bracket as shown below.



Regularly clean with mild liquid detergent or soap and water.



DO NOT use cream cleaners or bleach. These substances are abrasive.



DO NOT use cleaning pads with abrasive surfaces as this may scratch the material.
