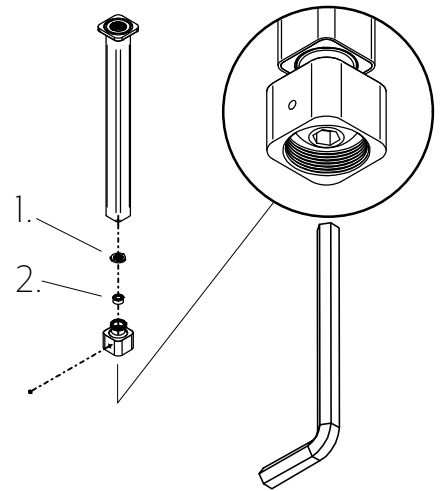
- ① Nesso shower head has been designed to be used with Nesso shower dropper & Nesso shower arm.
*Please note shower arm/dropper not included.
Shown for installation purposes only.



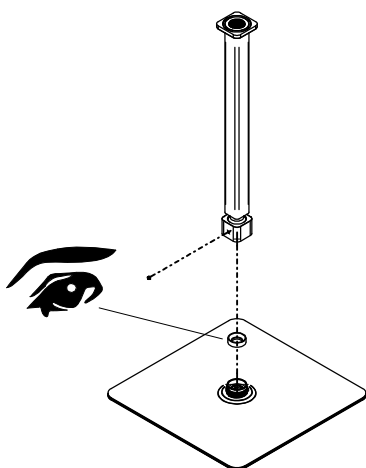
- ② Remove grub screw and unscrew swivel connection from shower head.



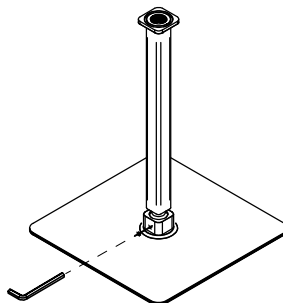
- ③ Install swivel connection into shower rail or dropper using 8mm Allen key.
*ensuring rubber o-ring (1) goes in first and flow controller (2) is carefully recessed into swivel connection to avoid damage from threads.



- ④ Screw shower head to the swivel connection, ensuring plastic slip collar is recessed into shower head.



- ⑤ Hand tighten until connection is square with shower head.
Tighten grub screw to fix in place.

1 x Shower head



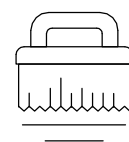
1 x Allen key



Regularly clean with mild liquid detergent or soap and water
